ABOUT

The **FIA World Rally Championship (WRC)** is one of the **world's** most diverse, exciting, and gruelling motorsport competitions. Always spectacular, dramatic and unpredictable, the WRC demands drivers show skill, courage, passion, endurance and the ability to adapt to constantly-changing conditions.

Kennards Hire Rally Australia is **the Australian leg of the WRC and the closing round of the season**. Coffs Coast will host this round on November 15-18, 2018 – the total event day attendance at last year's event was 63,565.

The Rally shares in the massive global coverage the WRC attracts, through television and other traditional media, plus online via its website and social media platforms. In 2017, TV coverage broadcast time totalled 828 hours and attracted **more than 41 million viewers in more than 150 markets**. Around 250 media representatives from around the world attend.

Tickets: 'Eat My Dust' or 3 Day pass gives access OR purchase tickets at the gate for \$10; 17yrs and under FREE.

See the cars complete the entire stage on the raceway as they transition from bitumen to gravel, making for exciting sideways action. A great spot for families to enjoy all the up-close action on the big screen with shade, food & drink.
