"We hit water on the cut and had a spin – a very very difficult stage. Much worse than this morning."

### **Car 2. ELFYN EVANS/DANIEL BARRITT**

"Very very difficult. To be honest it wasn't as bad toward the end – still some corners with zero grip. Just backing right off."

### **Car 1. SEBASTIEN OGIER/JULIEN INGRASSIA**

"I was driving this stage like my grandma would do – it was very tricky."

### **Car 9. ESAPEKKA LAPPI/JANNE FERM**

"I was so slow on the first time I could mark all the slippery places – so it was okay this time."

### **Car 10. MADS OSTBERG/TORSTEIN ERIKSEN**

"We have two difficult stages to go still. Conditions are tricky."

### **Car 6. HAYDEN PADDON/SEBASTIAN MARSHALL**

"Not the best way to finish the year for Thierry. We have to focus on our job. In these conditions we are taking it really really easy and just managing the gap."

### **Car 7. JARI-MATTI LATVALA/MIKKA ANTTILA**

"It was a good stage for us. First 3 km was extremely slippery. In some places it was getting better – but so easy to make a mistake."

### **Car 8. OTT TANAK/MARTIN JARVEOJA**

"I want to win but this is not the position to push for it – as you can see by what has been happening."

### **Car 4. ANDREAS MIKKELSEN/ANDERS JAEGER SYNNEVAG**

"We had to be very very careful in there and not take any risks. Just crawling through. This is not the result the team wanted – we can only look forward to next season."

**Car 33. ALBERTO HELLER/JOSE DIAZ**

“Very difficult now. We want to finish the rally and save the car – a very difficult stage.”

**Car 73. GAURAV GILL/GLENN MACNEALL**

“It has been a great week for us even after an unfortunate incident yesterday. Otherwise we have been having a great feeling with the car and tyres – had some good speed and looking forward to the next round.”

“It’s slipperier – the stage time is 30s slower than the first pass. The car has been bottoming out a lot more and could be extra weight from mud stuck underneath so may have to raise it up a bit.”
