Article 11. Scrutiny Schedule

Scrutiny Schedule (refer **Attachment 1**)

Note parking at scrutiny is limited. Please ensure you arrive within 10 minutes of your scheduled time and leave immediately after.

Article 12. Competitor Briefing

There will be a briefing on Wednesday, 13th November at 1930hrs for ALL NATIONAL crew members who haven't previously entered a WRC in 2019 to explain the operation of the SAS (RallySafe) unit. The WRC operation is different than that normally used for local events.

Location: Press Conference Room, Media Centre, Service Park (refer **Attachment 2**).

Article 13. Reconnaissance

Due to the number of entries, National Recce will be split into 2 Groups – ARC/RA Cup & 2 Day Event. On Tuesday the 2 Day Event crews don't do the first 2 stages (Mount Coramba & Lower Bucca) and they will start as first group on the remaining stages on that day. On Wednesday, the ARC/RA Cup will start first on all stages and the 2 Day Event crews don't do Wedding Bells19.

14 b) - Trailer parking – ARC/National

All car trailers must be parked in the Auxiliary Parking Area adjacent to the RA Cup / 2-Day Event Service Area and not in individual service bays.

Article 15. Shakedown and VIP Ride Day

All ARC competitors must attend the Shakedown/VIP Ride Day on Thursday 14 November 2019.

RA Cup crews are invited to attend from 1100hrs after first advising the CofC in writing prior to Friday 8 November 2019.

Article 17.1 - Rally Show & Ceremonial Start

Due to the larger number of entries than expected, the Day 1 Itinerary for RA 2-Day competitors has been changed.

2-Day Event crews will now compete over the Destination NSW Super Special Stage (SS1) prior to the Rally Show with **1st car starting at 1400hrs on Thursday 14 November 2019.**

Further details and revised Itinerary will be provided in a subsequent Bulletin.

ARC competitors are required to place their vehicles in the Rally Show area between 1450hrs and 1505hrs on Thursday 14 November.

RA Cup competitors are required to place their vehicles in the Rally Show area between 1500hrs and 1515hrs on Thursday 14 November.

It is not necessary that a member of the crew be the person who places the vehicle in the staging area

Article 17.2

For ARC competitors a tyre marking zone will be established before the yellow board at TC0. Crews must report to this zone a minimum of 2 mins before their Start Time at TC0.

Between TC0/2/9/10 and SS1/2/9/10, exhibition driving is allowed with the "Warm Up Area" shown in Thursday/Friday Road Book p29 & 83, including up to three doughnuts to warm the tyres.

Article 20. Rallysafe – Overtaking

The RallySafe Operation Manual is available on the Rally Australia Website (refer Competitors link, National tab). All competitors are encouraged to read and understand each function of the unit.

The Push-to-Pass function of the RallySafe unit will be advised in a subsequent Bulletin.

PART 2

2.1 RA Cup & RA 2-Day Event - Driving Suits

Irrespective of the CAMS Multi-Club Event Regulations relating to Apparel, all crews are required to wear driving suits during all promotional and competition activities.

2.2 Testing

Testing will be available on 2 separate stages within close proximity to each other. Both stages will be available and shared by both WRC and National crews.

A map & road book will be provided to those crews who have booked testing.

2.3 ARC Tyre quantities

In accordance with ARC Technical Regs Art 4(h) ARC competitors are permitted a maximum of 26 Tyres in total. The tyres used for the SSS are part of this tyre allocation. Tyres used for shakedown are not counted.

ARC competitors are advised that the use of “buffed” rally tyres for SS1 & SS2, **is not allowed** as this is classified as a “modification” to the tyres and is not allowed for crews in the WRC event.

2.4 RA Cup & 2-Day Event Service Area

Due to the high entry numbers the 2-Day Event Service area will now be moved to the newly constructed hardstand area adjacent to the WRC/ARC Service Park (refer **Attachment 2**).

2.5 Exit from Refuel area at Service Park

National crews are to continue past Box 3 a further 0.11km to enter refuel area and exit a further 0.12km later than Box 4.

2.6 Re-joining

Any car which fails to finish a Leg may be repaired at the competitor’s discretion. However, ARC & RA Cup cars must report to the overnight regroup prior to the next Leg no later than 4 hours before the scheduled start of the first WRC car.

2.7 Holding Areas

For the purposes of WRC ALL Live TV the target time between SS13 & TC14 and SS16 & TC17 has been made longer than would normally be allowed for the distance to be travelled.

Crews may not proceed beyond Saturday Page 39 Box 14 & Page 75 Box 14, earlier than 10 minutes before their due time at the following time control.

We have created Holding Areas at these locations where toilets, shade and water will be provided for crews. In the Road books we have shown “Holding Area (WRC Live TV)”.

2.8 Distance to RZ 8 in Itinerary

Itinerary shows RZ8 as being 14.62km after Welshs Creek Rev II but should be 9.32km (all other distances at RZ8 are correct).

2.9 ARC Penalties & Points Allocation

It is clarified that for the purposes of ARC Sporting Regs Appendix B Art 3 (WRC Art 46.2.3) the reference to the time penalty being added to ‘the fastest time achieved in its class by a non-priority driver’ may be the time taken by a non-priority driver competing in Rally Australia (WRC) to ensure consistency between competitors in either rally.

For those vehicles where there is no equivalent class in Rally Australia WRC the time used will be based on other competitors in the same class.

Competitors are referred to ARC Sporting Regs Appendix B Art 3 (WRC 46.2) which specifies the penalties which shall be used for this rally.

ARC crews entered in Rally Australia (WRC) are not able under the WRC regulations to rejoin at the final control on Sunday as is allowed under the ARC Sporting Regulations (ARC Sporting Regs Art 12.1(l)) therefore any ARC crew entered in Rally Australia WRC who wishes to rejoin at the finish for the purposes of point allocations will be deemed to have done so for the allocation of points if they book into TC25C within the prescribed time limit.

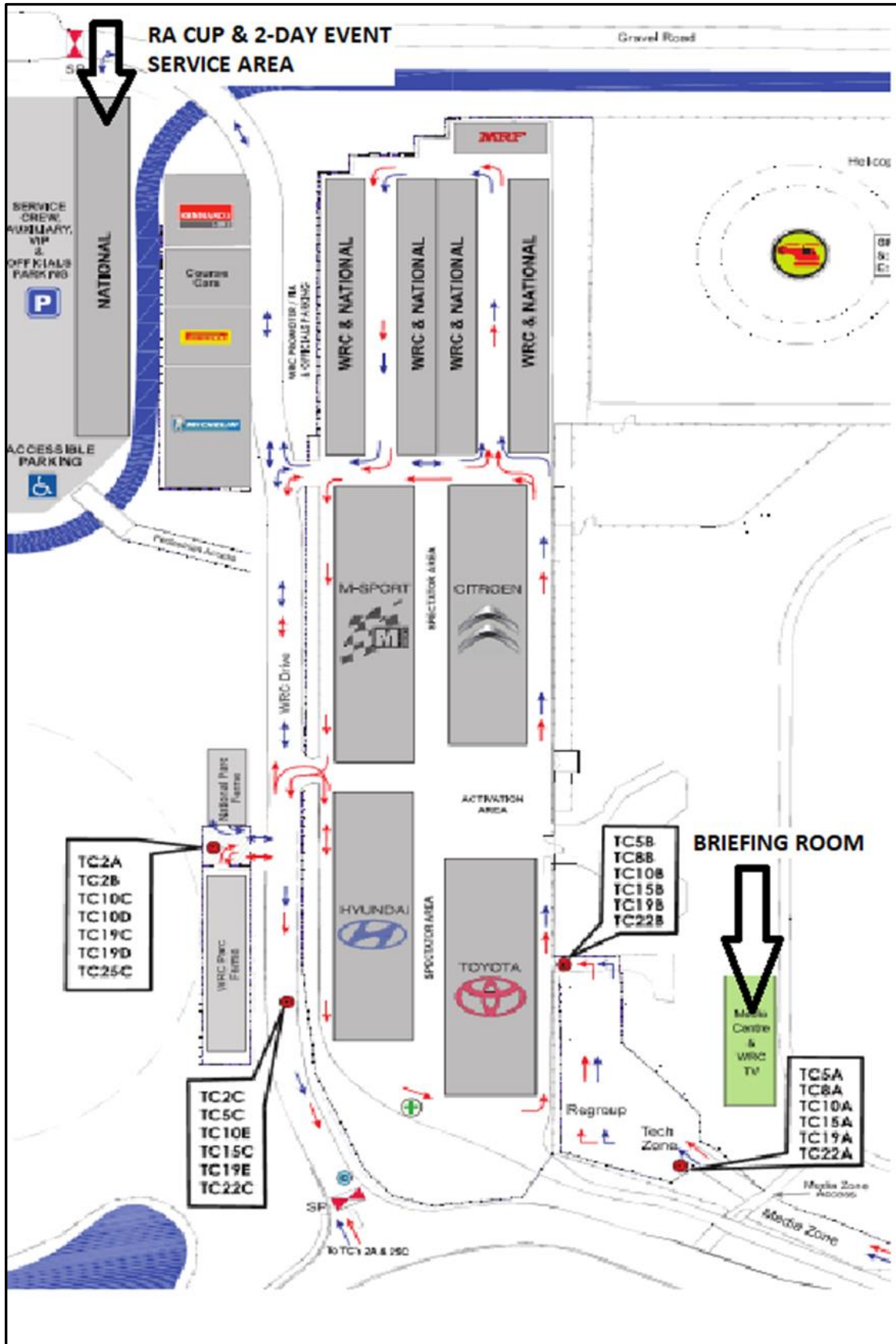
